


Is Your Family Taking Advantage of Credit Union Membership?



5 SIMPLE SAVINGS TIPS for FAMILIES

Raising a family is expensive. Try some of the following money-saving tips and use them to take charge of your budget!

- 1. Organize your grocery shopping.** The more organized you are when you go grocery shopping, the more money you can save. Have a list of items you need, coupons in an envelope and a maximum budget.
- 2. Eliminate one service each year that you can do without.** The potential here is almost unlimited. It can be a hardly used gym membership, a landline telephone service or cable TV.
- 3. Sell what you no longer need.** Instead of throwing away items you don't use, try selling them first to make some additional money. Have a garage sale once or twice per year, or try Craigslist or eBay.
- 4. Take better care of your health.** This is important for financial considerations. If you are healthier, you spend less on dealing with the fallout of common illnesses like cold and flu. You can save even more by avoiding controllable health conditions related to inactivity, obesity, smoking and other dangerous behaviors.
- 5. Save a minimum of 20% of your net pay.** Saving is not about having money for its own sake- it's about eliminating the panic factor that often causes you to spend more than you need to. Having money enables you to save money in a way that living hand-to-mouth never can. It takes you out of the state of crisis management, and gives you control over your circumstances. And that's what you need to properly care for your family.
